



## **ASSAULTER TACTICAL EMERGENCY MEDICINE II (ATEM II)**

**COURSE:** Assaulter Tactical Emergency Medicine II (ATEM II)  
(Program will be conducted 26-30 April 2010 in Bridgewater, Ma USA)

**PURPOSE:** This course is designed for medical personnel destined for or assigned to a tactical unit/organization. Training will include but not be limited to tactical marksmanship with the handgun, submachine gun/carbine and shotgun (breaching) as well as introductions to tactical team equipment, room combat/CQB (TIER I), personnel handling, assault team level tactical/medical planning, methods of entry (breaching), medical situation assessment, patient assessment in a tactical environment, rapid triage, management of multiple trauma patients, patient extraction, CCP establishment and hazardous material safety/awareness. Also included will be a variety of dry fire and live fire room combat/CQB including medical scenarios.

**PRE-REQUISITES:** The ATEM II Program is designed to prepare medical personnel for assignment to a tactical unit/organization. Attendees should be personnel destined for assignment to or a member of an operational tactical team.

**SPECIAL INFORMATION:** ATEM II is performance oriented training conducted in a high risk environment. To successfully complete the course a student must progress through increasingly difficult training. Testing will involve performance oriented "hands-on" application of the skills learned. The ATEM II Program has numerous live fire exercises, physical challenges, challenging medical scenarios, classroom lectures/conferences and graded presentations. The ATEM II Course is Missouri P.O.S.T. approved.

**CLASS SIZE/TUITION:** The course is limited to 16 personnel and will fill quickly. Tuition is \$750.00 per student.

**DIRECTIONS TO LODGING/STAGING SITE;** The host hotel for the ATEM II program and all SOTT-I LLC training in the Bridgewater area is the Fairfield Inn Marriott, 4 Chalet Road, Middleboro Massachusetts, 02346.
