



## **PRECISION SPORTING RIFLE PROGRAM (I/II)**

**COURSE:** Precision Sporting Rifle Program- I/II  
(Courses are held at the SOTT-I LLC Midwest Training Center, Cape Girardeau Missouri)

**PURPOSE:** The program is designed to focus upon the skills required to conduct precision shooting with the sporting rifle with emphasis on the use of optics. The training will highlight various techniques and procedures relative to precision sporting engagements and will cover SOTT-I LLC TIER I/II skills. This program teaches and reinforces the skills that will provide an overall enhancement of the shooters short to long range PSRMMS skills required to engage and down sporting game. The training will include but not be limited to:

- Precision Sporting Rifle Overview
- Weapons Etiquette and Handling
- Weapon Characteristics-Maintenance
- Weapon Disassembly and Assembly
- Precision Sporting Rifle Employment/Equipment
- Ammunition Types and Ballistics
- Applications of Fire (MOA/Environmental Factors)
- Data Book Overview and Use
- Estimating Range
- Precision Sporting Rifle Marksmanship (PSRMMS)
- Elevated Engagements
- Known and Unknown Distance Engagements (100-600 meters)
- Engaging Moving Game

**PRE-REQUISITES:** The Precision Sporting Rifle Program is designed to teach/reinforce PSRMMS and provide a foundation that will enhance the precision shooting skill sets for employment of the hunting rifle. Attendees are hunters and rifle enthusiasts wishing to enhance their precision rifle marksmanship skills with larger caliber sporting/hunting rifles. Small caliber rifles (example; .223) cannot be utilized.

**SPECIAL INFORMATION:** The Precision Sporting Rifle Program is performance oriented training conducted in a low-medium risk environment. Training will involve performance oriented "hands-on" application of the skills learned through numerous live fire exercises, classroom lectures/conferences and graded presentations.

**CLASS HOURS/SIZE/TUITION:** The course is conducted over two training days for a total of 20 hours and is limited to 20 personnel. Tuition is \$200.00 per student.
