



LOW PROFILE PROTECTOR TACTICAL OPERATIONS COURSE (LPPTO-C)

COURSE: Low Profile Protector Tactical Operations Course (LPPTO-C)
(Courses are held at the SOTT-I LLC Midwest Training Center, Cape Girardeau Missouri or a hosting customers location)

PURPOSE: This course is designed for personnel destined for assignment to a security/protection element, members of a security/protection element or for an entire "newly formed" security/protection element. Primary focus of the training is towards the security and protection of personnel and infrastructure to include special events, schools, churches and businesses. Training will include marksmanship with the handgun/carbine-rifle/shotgun, as well as introductions to tactical equipment, room combat/CQB (TIER I), personnel handling, limited breaching techniques and security/protective operations planning. Training will also progress to the conduct of dry fire scenarios and TIER I live fire room combat/CQB.

PRE-REQUISITES: The LPPTO-C is designed towards the instruction and training of the entry level security/protection elements and its members. This program is also beneficial to any security/protection element members who have attended some type of training in the past and are looking towards improving/refreshing their skills. Each attendee must be proficient. Attendees are civilian personnel operating or destined to operate in a protective security role as well as law enforcement, corrections or military personnel.

SPECIAL INFORMATION: The LPPTO-C is performance oriented training conducted in a high risk environment. To successfully complete the course a student must progress through increasingly difficult training. Testing will involve performance oriented "hands-on" application of the skills learned. The LPPTO-C Program has numerous live fire exercises, physical challenges, classroom lectures/conferences and graded presentations.

CLASS DURATION/SIZE/TUITION: Class duration is 5 days (60 hours). The course is limited to 24 personnel. Attendance by element or team is highly recommended but not required. Tuition is \$475.00 per student.

Reporting Instructions/ Driving Directions to the Midwest Training Center:

Directions: From I-55 take the Fruitland Exit (#105) and head north on Highway 61. Travel north on Highway 61 until you reach Highway 177. Travel east on Highway 177 until you reach Route V. Travel south on Route V until you come to the intersection of Route V and Route Y. Make a left and cross a bridge traveling east on Route V through Oriole, Missouri. Keep traveling east on Route V past Oriole approximately 1 mile, and you will start up a large hill. At the top of the hill there are two county roads directly across from one another (note the Midwest Training Center Sign with direction arrows). Turn right / south onto County Road 612 and travel approximately 0.7 miles. You will see a sign (SOTT-I LLC Midwest Training Center) and the large tan building.
