



AR-15/M16 FAMILY ARMORER COURSE

COURSE: AR-15/M-16 Family Armorer Course

(Courses are held at the SOTT-I LLC Midwest Training Center, Cape Girardeau Missouri)

PURPOSE: The program is designed to focus upon the skills required to effectively maintain and conduct operator level repairs to the rifle or carbine. The training will include but not be limited to;

- Introduction to the Rifle/Carbine
- Weapons Etiquette and Handling
- Weapon Characteristics-Maintenance
- Weapon Disassembly and Assembly
- Battle Sight Zero
- Ammunition Types and Ballistics
- Weapon Repair Overview
- Typical Weapon Problem Areas/Fixes
- Tools and Equipment

PRE-REQUISITES: The AR-15/M-16 Family Armorer Course is designed to provide an initial **base** skill set in order to enable the operator to maintain and repair an applicable weapon system. Attendees include civilian rifle enthusiasts, sworn law enforcement/correction officers or military personnel.

SPECIAL INFORMATION: The AR-15/M-16 Family Armorer Course is performance oriented training conducted in a low risk environment. Training will involve performance oriented "hands-on" application of the skills learned through classroom lectures/conferences to include a range period as well.

CLASS DURATION/SIZE/TUITION: Course is 1 day (12 hours). The course is limited to 30 personnel and will fill quickly. Tuition is \$125.00 per student.
