



PATROL RIFLE/CARBINE (TIER I-II)

COURSE: Patrol Rifle/Carbine (TIER I-II)
(Programs are held @ the SOTT-I LLC Midwest Training Center, Cape Girardeau Mo USA)

PURPOSE: The program is designed to focus upon the skills required to operate the patrol rifle/carbine as well as conduct tactical operations in an urban and rural environment. The training will highlight maintenance, operation and various tactics, techniques, procedures relative to the patrol rifle and will cover SOTT-I LLC TIER I-II skills with that weapon system. The training will include but not be limited to;

- Introduction to the Patrol Rifle/Carbine
- Weapons Etiquette and Handling
- Tactical Safety
- Weapon Characteristics-Maintenance
- Weapon Disassembly and Assembly
- Patrol Rifle Employment
- Tactical Mindset
- Ammunition Types and Ballistics
- Rifle Combat Marksmanship (RCMMS)
- Rifle Specialty Applications
- Shooting and Moving-Discriminatory Shooting
- Weapon deployment and employment
- Close Space Engagements
- Intro to Shooting from Vehicles

PRE-REQUISITES: The Patrol Rifle/Carbine (TIER I-II) Program is designed to provide an initial overview of the patrol rifle, teach RCMMS and provide a **base** skill set for employment. Attendees should be sworn law enforcement/correction officers or military personnel.

SPECIAL INFORMATION: The Patrol Rifle/Carbine (TIER I-II) Program is performance oriented training conducted in a medium risk environment. Testing will involve performance oriented "hands-on" application of the skills learned through numerous live fire exercises, classroom lectures/conferences and graded lessons.

This program is pending Missouri P.O.S.T. approval.

CLASS DURATION/SIZE/TUITION: Attendance is limited to 20 personnel per class. Tuition is \$200.00 per student.

Reporting Instructions/ Driving Directions to the Midwest Training Center:

Directions: From I-55 take the Fruitland Exit (#105) and head north on Highway 61. Travel north on Highway 61 until you reach Highway 177. Travel east on Highway 177 until you reach Route V. Travel south on Route V until you come to the intersection of Route V and Route Y. Make a left and cross a bridge traveling east on Route V through Oriole, Missouri. Keep traveling east on Route V past Oriole approximately 1 mile, and you will start up a large hill. At the top of the hill there are two county roads directly across from one another (note the Midwest Training Center Sign with direction arrows). Turn right / south onto County Road 612 and travel approximately 0.7 miles. You will see a sign (SOTT-I LLC Midwest Training Center) and the large tan building.
