



PRECISION RIFLE/CARBINE – I/II

COURSE: Precision Rifle/Carbine- I/II
(15-16 May 2010 @ the SOTT-I LLC Midwest Training Center, Jackson Mo USA)

PURPOSE: The program is designed to focus upon the skills required to conduct precision shooting with a rifle/carbine utilizing iron sights, aim-point type sights and various scopes. The training will highlight various tactics, techniques and procedures relative to precision engagements and will cover SOTT-I LLC TIER I/II skills with that weapon system. **NOTE: This IS NOT a sniper course.** This program teaches the skills that will provide for an overall enhancement of the shooters short to medium RCMM skills. The training will include but not be limited to;

- Precision Rifle/Carbine Overview
- Weapons Etiquette and Handling
- Weapon Characteristics-Maintenance
- Weapon Disassembly and Assembly
- Precision Rifle Employment
- Ammunition Types and Ballistics (Applications of Fire)
- Rifle Marksmanship (RMMS)
- Rifle Specialty Applications
- Shooting and Moving-Discriminatory Shooting
- Weapon deployment and employment at varying elevations/distances
- Known and Unknown Distance Engagements
- Estimating Range

PRE-REQUISITES: The Precision Rifle-I/II Program is designed to provide a review of the tactical rifle/carbine, teach/reinforce RMMS and provide a foundation that will enhance the precision shooting skill sets for employment of the weapon. Attendees are civilian rifle enthusiasts, sworn law enforcement/correction officers or military personnel.

SPECIAL INFORMATION: The Precision Rifle/Carbine-I/II Program is performance oriented training conducted in a medium risk environment. Training will involve performance oriented "hands-on" application of the skills learned through numerous live fire exercises, classroom lectures/conferences and graded presentations.

CLASS SIZE: The course is limited to 20 personnel and will fill quickly. Tuition is \$300.00 per student.

Reporting Instructions/ Driving Directions to the Midwest Training Center:

All students will report NLT 0745 the morning of the course start.
Directions: From I-55 take the Fruitland Exit (#105) and head north on Highway 61. Travel north on Highway 61 until you reach Highway 177. Travel east on Highway 177 until you reach Route V. Travel south on Route V until you come to the intersection of Route V and Route Y. Make a left and cross a bridge traveling east on Route V through Oriole, Missouri. Keep traveling east on Route V past Oriole approximately 1 mile, and you will start up a large hill. At the top of the hill there are two county roads directly across from one another (note the Midwest Training Center Sign with direction arrows). Turn right / south onto County Road 612 and travel approximately 0.7 miles. You will see a sign (SOTT-I LLC Midwest Training Center) and the large tan building.
