



REDUCED VISIBILITY HANDGUN MARKSMANSHIP

COURSE: RV-HMMS (TIER I-II)

(Program is held @ the SOTT-I LLC Midwest Training Center Cape Girardeau Mo USA)

PURPOSE: The program is designed to focus upon the skills required to effectively utilize the handgun during periods of reduced visibility. The training will highlight various tactics, techniques and procedures relative to handgun use during reduced visibility and will cover SOTT-I LLC TIER I-II skills with that weapon system. The training will include but not be limited to;

- Review of Students Handgun
- Weapons Etiquette and Handling
- Weapon Characteristics-Maintenance
- Weapon Disassembly and Assembly
- Ammunition Types and Ballistics
- Fundamentals of Handgun Marksmanship
- Normal Visibility Handgun Marksmanship (NV-HMMS)
- Reduced Visibility Handgun Marksmanship (RV-HMMS)
- White Light TTPs

PRE-REQUISITES: The RV-HMMS Program is designed to provide a skill set foundation regards the tactics, techniques and procedures regards conducting reduced visibility handgun marksmanship. Attendees include civilian handgun enthusiasts with a minimum of an entry level skill set, sworn law enforcement/correction officers or military personnel.

SPECIAL INFORMATION: The RV-HMMS Program is performance oriented training conducted in a low-medium risk environment. Training will involve performance oriented "hands-on" application of the skills learned through numerous live fire exercises, classroom lectures/conferences and graded presentations.

CLASS SIZE: The course is limited to 25 personnel and will fill quickly. Program includes two 10 hour days. Tuition is \$175.00 per student.

Reporting Instructions/ Driving Directions to the Midwest Training Center:

All students will report NLT 0745 the morning of the course start.
Directions: From I-55 take the Fruitland Exit (#105) and head north on Highway 61. Travel north on Highway 61 until you reach Highway 177. Travel east on Highway 177 until you reach Route V. Travel south on Route V until you come to the intersection of Route V and Route Y. Make a left and cross a bridge traveling east on Route V through Oriole, Missouri. Keep traveling east on Route V past Oriole approximately 1 mile, and you will start up a large hill. At the top of the hill there are two county roads directly across from one another (note the Midwest Training Center Sign with direction arrows). Turn right / south onto County Road 612 and travel approximately 0.7 miles. You will see a sign (SOTT-I LLC Midwest Training Center) and the large tan building.
